

# Dual Sport Participation Procedure

The athlete and his/her parent/guardian must submit an application to the Athletic Director and coaches involved before the first contest in either sport.

If both coaches are willing to allow dual participation to occur, a meeting of the Dual Sport Participation Council will be convened. The Dual Sport Participation Council is composed of the athlete's parent/guardian, priority head coach, secondary coach, Athletic Director and Principal/Asst. Principal. Dual Sport Participation requires unanimous agreement of the voting members.

## CRITERIA FOR SUBMITTING APPLICATION

The two head coaches must agree to abide by the conditions set by the Dual Sport Participation Council Meeting.

Student athlete must have a 2.3 GPA both cumulatively and currently.

Student athlete must declare his/her priority sport.

Student athlete will participate in his/her priority sport when contest and/or practice conflicts arise.

Conflicts must be minimal and are not to exceed 25% of the season.

Student athlete's Dual Sport Participation may be terminated if majority of the Dual Sport Participation Council believe it is in the student's best interest to cease dual participation. The student athlete will continue the priority sport only.
