The Northeastern Local School District's Transformation Team is continuing to work on revising the Scope of Work (SOW) for the 2011-2012 school year. Representatives of the team attending a meeting / work session sponsored by the Ohio Department of Education on May 4th to help guide the revision process.

The district continues to work on revising and "fine tuning" the Short Cycle Assessments that the district has developed to help measure student progress throughout the school year.

As the Ohio Department of Education begins to roll-out the new CORE standards, the Northeastern District has provided staff with "Crosswalk" documents that compare the old standards with the new standards. The district has held meetings, beginning with the Kindergarten teachers, to facilitate discussions on how the new standards will be implemented and what they will look like.

The Ohio Improvement Process (OIP) which is required by RtTT has been utilized by the district for the last two years to measure data and identify areas of strength and areas the need improvement. The individual buildings have also utilized the Building Improvement Process (BIP) to assess their individual building.
